The fees, premiums and funds charged to Regulated Members of the College of Alberta Denturists will fund costs normally incurred by the College in the processing and completing the registration applications and practice permit applications for those individuals, cover the Professional Liability Insurance Premiums and fund the Professional Conduct Fund.

ALL APPLICANTS:

- Payment of the invoiced amounts is due in full on or before the date specified by the College.
- Upon payment of the invoiced fees, (and electronic transmission of a complete and correct applicable application form) the Registrar must issue to the Regulated Member, a written confirmation that the Regulated Member is registered in the Province of Alberta, subject to his/her compliance with the Act, the Regulations, and the Bylaws.

RENEWAL APPLICANTS:

- Pursuant to the College of Alberta Denturists Bylaws, notification of fee, premiums and funds will be posted on the “Members” side of the College website at least 30 days before they are due. The notification will state the amount of the fees, premiums and dues and the date at which payment is required, and the consequences of failure to pay on or after that date.
- Each Regulated Member must pay to the College of Alberta Denturists an annual Practice Permit Fee by the date required by the College’s Bylaws.
- Where a Regulated Member pays the invoiced fees after the date required by the College by the date required, the Regulated Member must also pay a late payment fee.
- Pursuant to the Health Professions Act, where a Regulated Member fails to pay the fees by the date required by the College’s Bylaws, that Member’s Practice Permit is suspended and the Registrar may cancel the member’s Practice Permit; individuals cannot practice without a valid Practice Permit.
