



TILMA Agreement

Restrictions regarding TILMA movement between BC and AB

A. Alberta to British Columbia – no restrictions (unless individual has restrictions in place in AB).

B. British Columbia to Alberta – restrictions as follows:

1. Active Full

- i. restriction on provision of partial dentures until proficiency in survey and design and biological consideration in removable partial denture design, has been demonstrated
- ii. restriction on ordering of radiographs until proficiency in knowledge of radiographs, justification for ordering, and interpretation, has been demonstrated
- iii. restriction on provision of implant overdentures until proficiency in abutment selection and placement, implant retention design, laboratory and intraoral procedures has been demonstrated
- iv. restriction on providing a reduction of a subluxation of the TMJ until proficiency in the procedures has been demonstrated

2. Active Limited B

- i. restriction on provision of partial dentures until proficiency in survey and design and biological consideration in removable partial denture design, and proficiency in oral pathology, oral examination has been demonstrated
- ii. restriction on ordering of radiographs until proficiency in knowledge of radiographs, justification for ordering, and interpretation, has been demonstrated
- iii. restriction on provision of implant overdentures until proficiency in abutment selection and placement, implant retention design, laboratory and intraoral procedures has been demonstrated
- iv. restriction on providing a reduction of a subluxation of the TMJ until proficiency in the procedures has been demonstrated

3. Active Limited C

- i. restriction on provision of all services until proficiency in oral pathology, oral examination has been demonstrated; and
- ii. restriction on provision of partial dentures until proficiency in survey and design and biological consideration in removable partial denture design, has been demonstrated
- iii. restriction on ordering of radiographs until proficiency in knowledge of radiographs, justification for ordering, and interpretation, has been demonstrated
- iv. restriction on provision of implant overdentures until proficiency in abutment selection and placement, implant retention design, laboratory and intraoral procedures has been demonstrated
- v. restriction on providing a reduction of a subluxation of the TMJ until proficiency in the procedures has been demonstrated

4. Inactive

- i. Restrictions dependent on the Category of Registration prior to becoming Inactive

Additional Information

Restrictions:

- Individual cannot provide the restricted service until restriction removed by CAD; and/or
- May allow for provision of a restricted service, if in CAD approved supervised employment.

Justification:

- Alberta's scope of practice is significantly greater than that of BC registrants and therefore, BC registrants are not authorized to provide all services in the AB scope.
- In Alberta, there is no oversight by another healthcare provider, such as the requirement for dentist prescription and/or oral health certificate in British Columbia.
