The fees, premiums and funds charged to individuals who are International Applicants¹ making application for registration as a Regulated Member of the College of Alberta Denturists will fund costs normally incurred by the College in the processing and completing the registration applications and practice permit applications for those individuals, cover the Professional Liability Insurance Premium and fund the Professional Conduct Fund.

1. International applicants are required to pay an International Applicant registration application fee, the Regulated Member practice permit fee, professional conduct fee and professional liability insurance premium.
2. Payment of the invoiced amounts is due in full when the application is electronically submitted.
3. Any other fees related to the applicant obtaining documents, courses, or other such matters in order to meet the requirements indicated in the application documents and/or in the application process not indicated herein, are solely the responsibility of the applicant.
4. Reimbursement of fees is subject to applicable College Policies; the application fee is non-refundable.
5. Pursuant to the *Health Professions Act*, the Denturist Profession Regulation, the College's Bylaws and the College's Policies, the following are the fees assessed to International Applicants:

Regulated Member Annual Practice Permit Fee:	\$ 2149.53

* (Canadian Government General Sales Tax (GST) will be applied to applicable fees)

Premiums and Funds

Professional Liability Insurance Premium:	\$145.00
Professional Conduct Fund:	\$500.00

The aforementioned fees, premiums and funds are reviewed as necessary by the Council and adjusted accordingly.

¹ For the purposes of this policy, "International Applicant" means an applicant from a country other than Canada, or for an individual who is residing in Canada, having immigrated from a country other than Canada, and who has not previously been registered as a Denturist in Alberta or any other equivalent jurisdiction in Canada.
