The fees, premiums and funds charged to Regulated Members of the College of Alberta Denturists who are registered in the Courtesy Register, will fund costs normally incurred by the College in the processing and completing the registration applications and practice permit applications for those individuals, cover the Professional Liability Insurance Premiums and fund the Professional Conduct Fund.

- Each Individual who is making application for register as a Regulated Member in the Courtesy Register must pay to the College of Alberta Denturists an application fee, Regulated Member Courtesy Register Practice Permit Fee, and the Professional Conduct Fee Fund. If the applicants Professional Liability insurance will not cover the individual in Alberta, then the applicant must remit the premium for Professional Liability Insurance.
- Payment of the invoiced fees, premiums and funds is due in full on or before the date specified by the College.
- Upon payment of the invoiced amount (and remittance of a complete and correct applicable application form) the Registrar must issue to the Regulated Member, a written confirmation that the Regulated Member Registered in the Courtesy Register in the Province of Alberta, subject to his/her compliance with the Act, the Regulations, and the Bylaws.
- Registration in the Courtesy Register as per the Denturist Profession Regulation is to a maximum of six (6) months. All applications will be invoiced a Practice Permit Fee applicable to six (6) months of a Regulated Member Practice Permit Fee, and upon termination of the Courtesy Registration and if prior to the six (6) month expiry, the College of Alberta Denturists will issue a reimbursement of the pro-rated unused portion of the Courtesy Registration Practice Permit fee.
- The College of Alberta Denturists will not allow for any late payments of invoiced fees, premiums or funds, for applications of Registration in the Courtesy Register.
